A “signal phrase” introduces a quotation in order to help the reader understand why it is important and how it fits into the rest of the paper. APA recommends using 12 pt. Times New Roman font. Include a page header (also known as the "running head") at the top of every page. To create a page header/running head, insert page numbers flush right. Then type "TITLE OF YOUR PAPER" in the header flush left using all capital letters.
