ENACTIVE LEARNING Learning by observing other people or modeling. VICARIOUS LEARNING Learning by doing and experience, consequences act as information. Reciprocal Determinism : Distinguishes between acquisition of knowledge and the observable performance.

Bruner's Theory of Constructivism The outcome of cognitive development is thinking. The intelligent mind creates from experience "generic coding systems that permit one to go beyond the data to new and possibly fruitful predictions" (Bruner, 1957, p. 234).

The enactive interface in the figure interprets manual input and provides a response in perceptual terms in the form of images, sounds, and haptic (tactile) feedback. The system is called enactive because of the feedback loop in which the system response is decided by the user input, and the user input is driven by the perceived system responses.
