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### Example Of Review Systems Documentation

The review of systems is distinct. For example, if the documentation read, "The patient states she has a sore throat," credit would not be given to both the HPI location and to the review of the ENT system. But if the documentation specifies, "The patient states that she has a sore throat.

E&M documentation involves three components: History; Exam; Medical decision making; The history component entails three parts: Review of systems ROS; Past, family and social history PFSH; Chief complaint and elements to the history of the present illness HPI; History, Review of Systems

### E&M Documentation Requirements: A Look at 'Review of Systems'

The Review of Systems (ROS) is an inventory of specific body systems performed by the physician in the process of taking a history from the patient. The ROS is designed to bring out clinical symptoms which the patient may have overlooked or forgotten.

REVIEW OF SYSTEMS: He has had no frank gross hematemesis, no melena or black tarry stools. No dizziness, feeling faint, visual disturbances, ear, nose or throat complaint, cough, shortness of breath, sputum production, chest pain, periumbilical pain, right lower quadrant pain, right upper quadrant pain, postprandial discomfort, rashes, skin breakdown, numbness, tingling or paralysis.

### Ventura Family Medicine - Full Review of Systems

It is still acceptable to use the statement, "All other systems were reviewed and are negative." But a word of caution: When using the "all other systems reviewed and negative" statement, make sure you're performing a 10-plus system review. The statement is a documentation shortcut, not a performance one, and physicians still need to review at least 10 systems. Also, your documentation should clearly communicate performing a "complete" review of systems.

Documentation guidelines are identified by the symbol • DG. The descriptors for the levels of E/M services recognize seven components which are used in defining the levels of E/M services. These components are: history; examination; medical decision making; counseling; coordination of care; nature of presenting problem; and time.
