How To Read Bass Tab Tab Under Notation. In tab, the horizontal lines represent the strings. If the part is written for a standard four string bass then there will be four horizontal lines, one for each string. The bottom line of tab represents the E string, the top line represents the G string.

On to how to read bass tabs... Strings in Bass Tab. Bass tab shows the strings of the bass drawn horizontally. Most often bass tab is written for 4-string bass, but you may see it for 5-string and 6-string basses, too. That will depend on whether more strings are required to play the song. The bass strings are drawn with the lowest-pitched string at the bottom (E). Standard bass tuning from lowest to highest is E-A-D-G and looks like this: G

The F clef, called Bass clef, is used on sheet music for piano (left hand), cello, double bass, bass guitar, bassoon, trombone, tuba, timpani... Baritone and bass voice use the Bass clef too. The bass clef (F clef) is placed on the fourth line of the staff.

Figured Bass - what it is, and how it works

Bass tab features four horizontal lines that represent each of your strings; the line at the very bottom represents your low E string, while the line at the top represents your G string. The numbers on the lines represent what fret to play. Read the tab from left to right, playing only the notes indicated by the numbers.

The bass clef. On the piano, the bass clef contains lower-pitched notes, the ones below middle C, including all the notes you play with your left hand. Another name for the bass clef is the F clef. The curly top of the clef partly encircles where the F note is on the staff, and it has two dots that surround the F note line.
